CHRISTMAS EVE

If you have some last-minute gift wrapping to take care of or have a treatment booked in The Spa, we have a pre-booked supervised session available in The Den from 3pm–5pm where the children can make reindeer food to leave out for Santa's four legged friends. At 5.15pm the Den team will be taking the children out onto the lawn to sprinkle the feed. If you would like to join us please meet at reception at 5.10pm.

In the lounge you will find cups, plates, mince pies, carrots and milk. Santa has a busy night ahead and would be very grateful if you could make him up a plate of treats and leave these outside your door with your stocking.

Our open log fire is roaring in the lounge where mulled wine and mince pies will be served from 3.30pm–5pm, a fantastic opportunity to meet with family and fellow house guests. Our younger guests can choose to dine at high tea from 5–6pm or family dining from 6–7pm.

BOXING DAY

Breakfast will be served from 8am–10am.

Treatments are available to be booked today from 10.30am–5.30pm and the spa facilities will be open 8am–8pm.

The Den team will be available for your pre-booked two hour supervised session today from 10am–12pm or 3pm–5pm.

Our traditional family treasure hunts will take place today, choose from the hunt that can be done on foot in and around the hotel or head off in your car for a more adventurous treasure hunt that will culminate at Beaulieu where you will be given tickets to enjoy the attraction before heading back.

You can collect your treasure hunt and Beaulieu tickets from reception.
